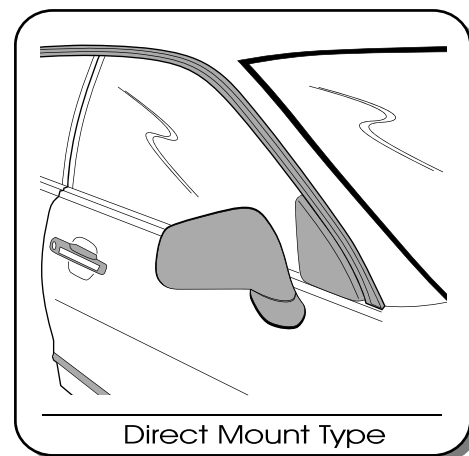
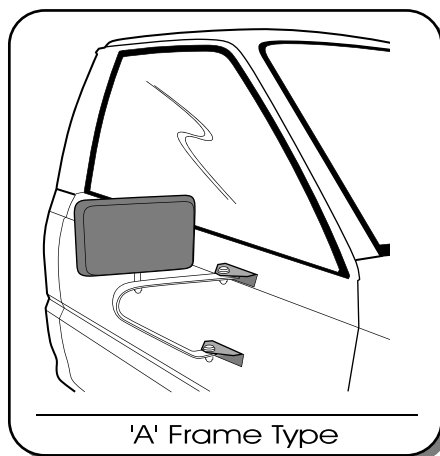
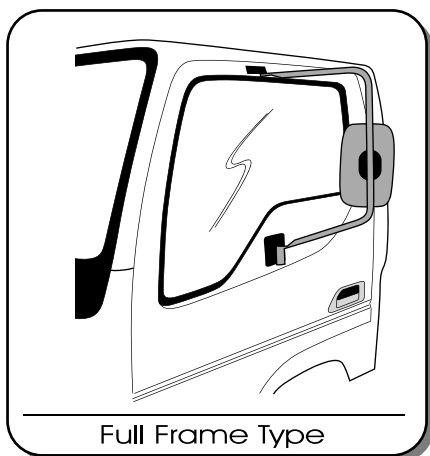
Issue raised: **Door Mirror Descriptions, General**

This bulletin is to aide in the description of our range of door mirrors. We supply a variety of mirrors for all types of vehicles and in some cases multiple styles for one vehicle.

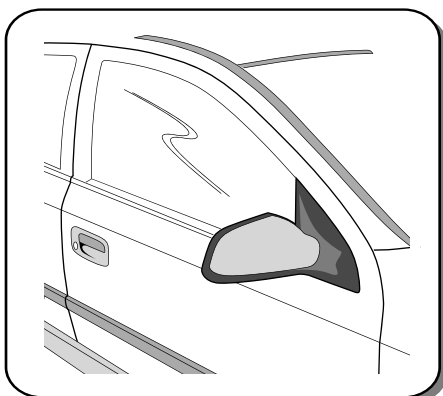
In the 2003 Trade Catalogue door mirrors are described as being either “**sail mount**” or “**skin mount**”. Below are basic diagrams depicting key differences between mirror types.

### Skin Mount Mirrors



**Note:** All **Skin Mount** mirrors secure to the outer door skin either by a frame or directly from the mirror's base. They do not require a mounting frame to be described as a **Skin Mount**.

### Sail Mount Mirrors



**Sail Mount** mirrors have a sail shaped base which is secured to the door frame it self in the angled front section.

**Note:** No part of the mirror sail is secured to the outer door skin further more no bolts are found on the exterior of the mirror sail.
